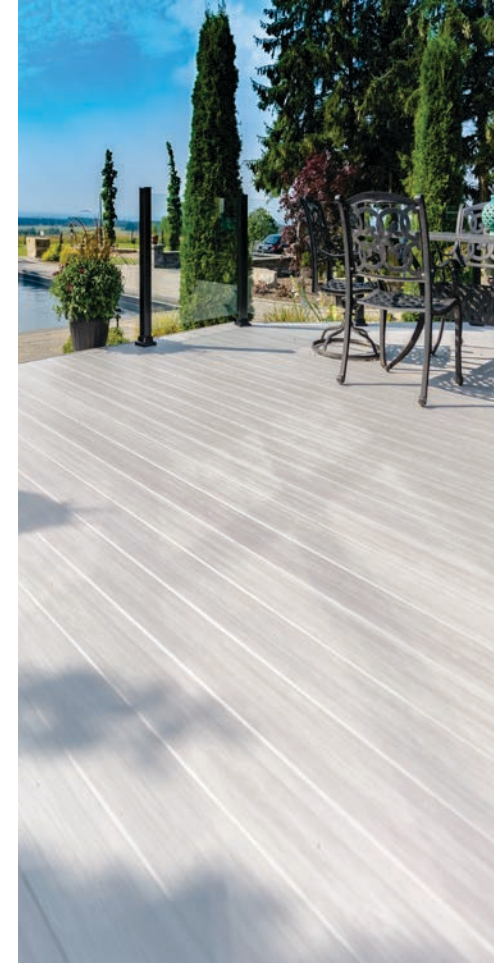

Residential Applications

Sunspace Modular Enclosures Inc., (the manufacturer), guarantees the materials factory workmanship, the original purchaser, to be of excellent quality as provided in this limited non-prorated warranty.

- Sunspace guarantees AlumaDeck Aluminum Decking to be free from manufacturing defects.
- Sunspace guarantees that it's AlumaDeck Aluminum decking, in residential applications will not split, peel, flake, blister or fracture under conditions of normal use for 20 years from date of purchase.
- This warranty does not cover chalking, scratching or fading caused by a corrosive atmosphere including contamination by, but not limited to; chemical fumes, pollution, explosions, salt.
- This warranty does not cover damage caused by weather including, but not limited to; lightning, windstorms, tornadoes, fire, floods, earthquakes, or any other act of God.
- Any misuse or abuse of this product automatically voids this warranty.
- This warranty does not include any screws or other fasteners used in the assembly and/or installation of this product.
- Sunspace will honor this warranty if the AlumaDeck Aluminum Decking has been installed by an authorized Sunspace Dealer according to local building code regulations in force at the time of installation. The warranty will not be honored if the product has been modified or altered in any manner, whether at the time of installation or anytime thereafter, by anyone other than an authorized Sunspace dealer.
- Before this warranty is honored, Sunspace will be given a reasonable opportunity to have the claim investigated by one or more of its representatives. If, after the investigating the claim, Sunspace is found to be the sole liable party, the remedy shall be as follows:
 - Sunspace will choose, at its own discretion, to either repair or replace any of the railing and/or fencing that is deemed to be defective. The cost of labor as well as any shipping costs shall be the responsibility of the claimant.
- This warranty is for the exclusive benefit of the original purchaser and is not assignable or transferable. All claims against this warranty must be made within 14 days after the circumstances giving rise to the claim are discovered by the claimant.
